## Terrain description and race area

The terrain consists predominantly of mixed open deciduous forest with few areas of coniferous forest.

There is an extensive network of paths, roads and ditches. The area varies with moderate to strong slopes, and with diverse runnability. In general, the forest is relatively open with a good deal of blackberry growing in dense groups and some undergrowth.

The Northern part is intersected by a busy road.

The high degree of variation makes it a challenging and intriguing terrain for orienteering.
