UPDATED ACCORDING TO COVID-19 REGULATIONS



COVID-19 regulations	The Corona rules from the Danish authorities have been updated and as a consequence of this the championship is divided into independent event:			
	 "DM Young" with start in the morning from 10:00 for the classes up to and including W/M50. "DM Senior" with start in the afternoon from app. 14:00 for the classes from and including W/M55 and older. 			
	It will be possible to pre-register for open courses in both events. No courses will be on sale on the day of the event.			
	 Other changes: No club tents are allowed on the venue and there will be no kiosk. Only online results will be available. No children' s courses. 			
	 Water will be available in the finish area in bottles which are handed out by officials. Due to the restrictions against assembling, the orienteers are 			
	encouraged to go directly from the parking area to the Start shortly before the start time, and again leave the venue shortly after finish line.			
	 Persons driving together should as far as possible spend waiting time in the car both before start as well as after finish.

Terrain description and race area	The terrain consists predominantly of mixed open deciduous forest with few areas of coniferous forest.
	There is an extensive network of paths, roads and ditches. The area varies with moderate to strong slopes, and with diverse runnability. In general, the forest is relatively open with a good deal of blackberry growing in dense groups and some undergrowth.
	The Northern part is intersected by a busy road.
	The high degree of variation makes it a challenging and intriguing terrain for orienteering.

	As the championship is split into two events, there will be individual starts either in the morning or afternoon, depending on the selected class.				
	Starting interval: Minimum 1 min.				
	Call up will be 4 min. before start.				
	Participants in classes with difficulty green (beginner) and white (easy) will have the map handed out 2 min. before start and will be offered help with the start from an official.				
	Open courses are started after the ordinary DM classes in the morning and afternoon, respectively.
